ELECTIVES DESCRIPTIONS

Basic Tumbling *By Actors' Gymnasium*

WED | Grades K—2 \$171

Actors Gymnasium teachers will lead students in grades K-2 through a warm up, and will play games that will help them build physical awareness. Each week, students will learn a series of basic conditioning and tumbling skills that will help them learn things like balance, coordination, and will build the strength they need to continue learning more advanced gymnastics in a non-competitive, fun environment.

Chess Club *By GM Chess Academy*

MON | Grades K—5 \$160

Chess Club is open to students K-5 of all chess knowledge. Beginners will be taught the basics of the chess game, returning and advanced students will be lead through various chess openings, endgames, strategies and tactics. GM Vladimir Georgiev and National Master Gopal Menon both use interactive instruction with lots of exercises. Students will be encouraged to participate in local and State tournaments.
